Dear: Exhibitor:

Please find enclosed details of boarding plans for the 2008/2009 Wellington shows at the Palm Beach International Equestrian Center managed by Equestrian Sport Productions, LLC (ESP).

We are offering several stabling options to meet the needs of as many exhibitors as possible, ranging from a package for the 2009 Winter Equestrian Festival to an extended boarding package beginning December 1, 2008 through to April 20, 2009. This letter clarifies an earlier announcement of the new extended package for the 2008/2009 season which, because it did not include the other stabling options, caused some confusion. Details of the extended package were announced to meet the needs of numerous exhibitors who stated they plan to compete in Wellington earlier than previous years and to extend their schedule beyond WEF.

ESP has created six different boarding plans tailored to the needs of exhibitors. For example:

For the 12 weeks of the 2009 Winter Equestrian Festival--January 5-March 30, 2009--the cost per stall will be \$3,000 on the North (WEF) Grounds, which equates to \$250 per stall per week.

The extended plan covering 20 weeks from December 1, 2008 to April 20, 2009, is \$4,500 per stall on the North (WEF) Grounds amounting to \$225 per stall per week.

Significant savings can be achieved by stabling at the South Grounds, formerly Littlewood.

Due to the substantial number of requests for stabling received so far, ESP recommends ordering stalls as soon as possible

The Wellington winter season kicks off with the inaugural Palm Beach Steeplechase on Saturday, November 29, 2008 at the PBIEC Stadium (formerly Palm Beach Polo Grounds). An "A" rated show will also be offered the same week at PBIEC show grounds, hosted by South Florida Hunter Jumper Association.

The first "AA" rated show of the season, Holiday & Horses, is scheduled for Dec. 3-7. This show features a CSI 3\* World Cup qualifying event, a Six Bar, Puissance and Gamblers Choice jumping contests and holiday-themed family entertainment from a tree lighting ceremony to ice skating.

The 2009 WEF includes more than \$5 million in prize money for hunters and jumpers and the richest dressage competition in the world. Other highlights include a Jumper Derby on grass at the PBIEC Stadium, an International Hunter Derby, the second year of the George H. Morris Excellence in Equitation, eight planned evening competitions including the universally popular Nations Cup and newly created "Battle of the Sexes" and the introduction of an Adult Equitation League.
